

# AirDuo RespiClick Inhaler and Fluticasone Propionate/Salmeterol Powder Inhaler

*Medicine: Fluticasone (floo-TIK-a-son) and Salmeterol (sal-MEH-ter-ahl)*

## What it does

This inhaler has 2 medicines that relax the muscles in your airway. It works over time to reduce swelling and mucus.

## How to use this inhaler

1. Wash and dry your hands well.
2. **Don't** shake the inhaler.
3. Hold the inhaler upright and open the cap all the way until you hear a click.
4. Breathe out through your mouth away from the inhaler.
5. Close your lips tightly around the mouthpiece.
6. Breathe in deeply through your mouth. Be careful not to block the air vent on the inhaler with your lips or fingers.
7. Remove the mouthpiece and hold your breath for 10 seconds, or as long as you can.
8. Breathe out through your mouth slowly, away from the inhaler. Close the inhaler cap firmly after each inhalation. This gets the inhaler ready for the next dose.
9. If you need to take another dose, be sure to close the cap, then repeat steps 3 to 9.
10. Rinse your mouth after the last dose and spit the water out. Don't swallow.

11. Store the inhaler in a cool, dry place.

**Important:** Open the inhaler only if you're ready to take your dose. Each time you open and close the cover, the counter counts down by 1. You'll lose the dose if you close the cover without taking the medicine.

## Cleaning

Keep the inhaler dry at all times. Wipe the mouthpiece with a dry cloth if needed.

## How to tell if the inhaler is empty

This inhaler has 60 doses. It's empty when the dose counter reads 0. When you have less than 20 doses left, the numbers will turn red to remind you to get a refill.

Throw away the inhaler 30 days after you open the foil pouch. Or throw it away when the dose counter reads 0, whichever comes first.
